The records of the Department indicate you are the holder of Motor Bus Certificate Number 3. The records of the Department further indicate that you are allegedly in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

- CGS Section 13b-80, 86, 93, as amended, by violating the terms of the Certificate which require the Certificate holder to comply with all pertinent laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically, on February 7, 2019 Mr. John F Nason, Managing Member, sent a letter to Mr. Ricardo Almeida informing him that Nason Partners, LLC will be suspended service as of February 8, 2019. Mr. John F Nason also asked to be informed on how and when the Bureau of Public Transportation plan to pick up buses and equipment bringing to the attention of the Department that Nason Partners, LLC, DBA Kelley Transit Company could allegedly be in violation of the following:


- Connecticut General Statutes:
  - o Sec 13b-80 – Certificate of public convenience and necessity.
  - Continuity of service (suspending bus service).
  - o Sec 13b-86 – Common carrier subject to jurisdiction of department.
  - Continuity of service (suspending bus service).
  - o Sec 13b-93 – Discontinuation of service (Mr. John F Nason notify the Department and the public of the discontinuance of service).

As a result, you are subject to a hearing pursuant to CGS 13b-80, 86, and 93. In addition, you are subject to a penalty pursuant to CGS 13b-80 and 90.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 4-182, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the office of the Department of Transportation Administrative Law Unit, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut 06111, on July 25, 2019, Hearing Room A, at 1:30 pm for a Show Cause hearing as to why this Certificate #3 should not be revoked, suspended and/or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
