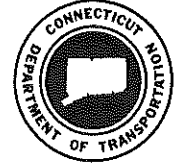

The records of the Department of Transportation (Department) indicate that you are the holder of Household Goods Carrier Certificate No. HG1719. The records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) as amended:

- CGS, Section 13b-392 (Formerly Sec. 16-286): Considerations for granting certificate: suitability.
- CGS, Section 13b-394 (Formerly Sec. 16-288): Discrimination prohibited.
- CGS, Section 13b-395 (Formerly Sec. 16-289): Change in rates.

The alleged incident in question violates the terms of the certificate which requires the certificate holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations, and orders of the department.

More specifically, on January 6, 2022, the Department received a complaint from Mr. Larry Ivitile alleging that an incident occurred during a scheduled household goods move on November 9, 2021, between the complainant and three crew members from Worldwide Moving and Storage, Inc. The allegations detail a move that was not completed to a professionally acceptable standard as the crew members were not willing to dismantle certain items in order to move them safely which resulted in significant damage to the complainant's property. The complainant also presented allegations that are of extreme concern as they detail multiple violations such as a change in rates and discrimination. The allegations of this incident and the certificate holder's lack of cooperation with the Hamden Police Department's investigation present extreme safety concerns that have given the department cause to challenge the suitability of the management for this certificate.

As a result, you are subject to a hearing and potential penalties pursuant to CGS 13b-410 and 13b-414. Your certificate is also subject to a possible revocation pursuant to CGS 13b-407.


Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 4-182, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear by telephone for a hearing on May 26, 2022 at 10:00 AM for a Show Cause hearing as to why this Certificate should not be revoked, suspended and/or the imposition of an additional civil penalty for

failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
