The hearing originally for A Premier Limousine Service, Inc. DBA Premier Limousine scheduled for Thursday, February 14, 2013 for 11:00 a.m., Docket No. 1210-C-146-L, has been replaced with Docket No. 1206-C-89-L, A Premier Limousine Service, Inc. DBA Premier Limousine.

The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 2836, and are in violation of Connecticut General Statute Section 13b-103, as amended, by violating the terms of the permit which requires the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically, the records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Sections of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

- 16-325-3 Failure to notify or request a change of address
- 16-325-4 Change location of headquarters to Stamford without approval
- 16-325-7 Failure to follow tariff charges
- 16-325-8 Operating more vehicles than authorized
- 16-325-9 Operating vehicles in livery service that have not been approved
- 13b-103 Operating intrastate without permit, Headquarters location
- 13b-109 Failure to show Connecticut permit number in advertisements as required

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room A on Thursday, February 14, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this certificate should not be revoked or suspended or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
