The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 2546, and are in violation of Connecticut General Statute Sections 13b-102, 13b-103, 13b-106 as amended, by violating the terms of the Permit which requires the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically, on March 5, 2012 a vehicle bearing Z9734Z was observed dropping off a passenger at the New Haven Rail Station, it was confirmed that the trip was an intrastate trip. Mr. Dennis King conducted the interview of the passenger Mr. Covino who confirmed the he was picked up in Connecticut.

This is a direct violation of Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes, operating intrastate without a permit.

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room A on Thursday, May 10, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this permit should not be revoked or suspended or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
