WHEREAS, community leaders and parents should determine the "bikeability" of their community and identify any potential challenges to safe bicycling using a bikeability checklist; and

WHEREAS, community members and leaders should make a plan to enable children to safely bicycle and walk in our communities; and


WHEREAS, children, parents and community leaders around Connecticut should join together to improve bicycling and walking opportunities in their communities; and
