#### Q&A:

- Following the presentation, a recorded Q&A was conducted
- There were a total of four questions, three asked directly via raised hand, one via the Q&A box. There was also one comment received.
- The questions and the follow up answers are below
  - o (Town of Southington): Is there going to be any detouring on local roads?
    - A: Most of the ramp detouring will be on state roads. A travel on local roads will be close connections to state roads. Majority of detours set up to maintain traffic on state roads. All detours will be signed and posted on the project website.
  - (Roger): There are a few structures in the interchange of I-91 and I-691 that have cathodic protection. Are we dealing with this and is it successful?
    - A: Cathodic protection is in use across the nation, including Connecticut. While
      not included in this project, the State's cathodic protection method of choice
      are cathodic anodes. As of today, cathodic protection has performed well.
  - o (Pat): Will this work be torn up when the I91-691-15 interchange is rebuilt?
    - A: No. The project limits of these projects do not overlap. The only overlap, but no impact are the overhead signs. The signs in this project will be good for that project as well.
