# **Current Precautionary Control Measures Updated 8/6/2021**

CTDOT COVID19 Safety Directives - COVID Safety Directives issued by the CTDOT Division of Occupational Health and Safety may be revised, as needed, in response to updated or emerging requirements and guidance. Specific requirements or steps in any CTDOT COVID Safety Directive may be adapted to meet the specific needs of a COVID case, with the approval of the CTDOT Division of Occupational Health and Safety.

8/6/2021 Update – Effective Immediately - All protocols identified in the CTDOT COVID Safety Directives are required regardless of the employee's vaccination status.

8/6/2021 Update - Effective Immediately - All CTDOT employees identified as a close contact to someone who has tested positive for the COVID19 virus are required to be tested (PCR) between 3 to 5 days from the close contact exposure. Test results are to be submitted to the OHS Division and HR.

### **8/6/2021 Update – Effective Immediately -** Face coverings are required:

- Upon entering any CTDOT facility and while in all common areas within a facility.
- At all times when there are 2 or more people in a conference room, meeting room, training room, breakroom, or other similar congregate setting, regardless of the room's maximum COVID occupancy number or the ability to physically distance.
- There are no changes to the protocols or requirements for face coverings while an employee is in a cubical by themselves as long as 6 feet of physical distancing can be maintained or where the partition walls or other physical separations extend at least 30 inches above the desktop or while alone in an office or vehicle.
