VERY CONCERNED

Employees voiced strong concerns about potential COVID-19 exposures at work

54% VERY CONCERNED31% SOMEWHAT CONCERNED9% NOT CONCERNED6% DID NOT ANSWER

MOST CONCERNED OF COVID-19 EXPOSURES....

...in general-use areas, such as entrances, elevators, restrooms, and breakrooms (49% of responses)

TOP 3 CONCERNS...

#1 - The close proximity of workspace to other employees (the ability to social distance)

#2 - The availability of masks, face coverings, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes or other similar items

#3 - Someone in their household is considered to be high risk for COVID-19

WILLINGNESS TO WEAR A MASK

Top reasons for <u>not</u> being able to wear a mask: medical, difficulty breathing, heat, visibility (fogged glasses/safety goggles)
