VERY CONCERNED

Employees voiced strong concerns about potential COVID-19 exposures at work

MOST CONCERNED OF COVID-19 EXPOSURES...

- 54% VERY CONCERNED
- 31% SOMEWHAT CONCERNED
- 9% NOT CONCERNED
- 6% DID NOT ANSWER

...in general-use areas, such as entrances, elevators, restrooms, and breakrooms (49% of responses)

TOP 3 CONCERNS...



- #1 - The close proximity of workspace to other employees (the ability to social distance)
- #2 - The availability of masks, face coverings, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes or other similar items
- #3 - Someone in their household is considered to be high risk for COVID-19

WILLINGNESS TO WEAR A MASK
