



# I-95 PEARL HARBOR MEMORIAL ("Q") BRIDGE



A Final Environmental Impact Statement/Section 4(f) Evaluation (FEIS) has been approved for the Interstate 95 (I-95) crossing over New Haven Harbor (Pearl Harbor Memorial/"Q" Bridge). The FEIS includes a description and evaluation of the Recommended Action. The following Recommended Action traverses approximately 7 miles of Interstate 95 between Interchanges 46 in New Haven and 54 in Branford.

## TRANSIT AND TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM MANAGEMENT COMPONENTS:

- Shore Line East rail passenger service, New Haven-New London.
- A new Shore Line East rail passenger station on State Street, New Haven.
- Connecticut Transit fixed route bus service, Branford-New Haven.
- Rideshare programs focusing upon the following:
  - HOV Preferential Parking (voluntary).
  - Public and Private Carpool Matching.
  - Auto Insurance Discount for Rideshare/Transit Users (voluntary).
  - Carpool Marketing.
  - Optimized Flex Time.
  - Guaranteed Ride Home.
  - Improved Transit Marketing.

## HIGHWAY COMPONENTS:

- A new 10 lane I-95 bridge crossing New Haven Harbor with interchange improvements.
- A reconfigured I-95/I-91/Route 34 Interchange.
- Widen I-95 between the new bridge crossing and Interchange #54, Branford.
