

SUMMARY OF THE JULY 2001 SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATIONS
TO THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS
FORM 815

Thee most recent significant changes are summarized below:

- Supplemental Specification 101 better defines the word “Materials” and adds new definitions and new abbreviations commonly used on the Department’s Facilities projects.
- Supplemental Specification 105 specifies how conflicting industry standards are to be addressed and adds language requiring the Contractor to verify dimensions and measurements.
- Supplemental Specification 106 more clearly describes the Department’s expectations for delivery and handling of materials to the project site.
- Supplemental Specification 107 specifies the conditions that the Contractor must meet if he requests to use State owned property for purposes other than the construction activities included in the contract.
- Supplemental Specification 707 eliminates minimum curing times to allow for the use of “rapid cure” primers when installing woven glass fabric membrane.
- Supplemental Specification M08 is revised to reference the proper specification for the design of reinforcing in rectangular catch basins.
