REGISTRATION OF FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION AUTHORITY

By application 1911-I-120-L, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (Department) on November 19, 2019, Norma Garcia dba Ms. Norma For You (applicant) of Bridgeport, Connecticut, seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in certificate number MC-1085006, issued on January 28, 2020. The applicant submitted the requisite criminal conviction history form, conducted in accordance with Section 29-17a of the Connecticut General Statutes.

After consideration by the Department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-102(b), and Livery Permit Number 3683 is issued to Norma Garcia dba Ms. Norma For You in the following form:

Norma Garcia dba Ms. Norma For You is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-1085006.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the Permit Holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit.

This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder thereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder.

A Memorandum of the Permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
