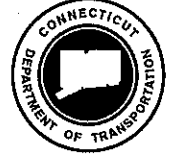

I. INTRODUCTION

By application 2002-AVWO-22-L, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on February 20, 2020, BDL Livery, LLC dba Jaguar Limo (hereinafter "applicant") made application for two (2) additional motor vehicles in general livery service from a headquarters in Windsor Locks under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-103(a)(4).

The applicant, holder of Livery Permit No. 3454, is currently permitted and authorized to operate seven (7) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less in general livery service between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Windsor Locks.

In addition, BDL Livery, LLC dba Jaguar Limo is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers in charter and special operations in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-135240-C.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before the Department.
2. It has been at least one calendar year since the applicant last applied for additional vehicle(s).
3. Department records indicate that all the existing vehicle(s) authorized are registered and in use.
4. Department records further indicate that there are no outstanding violations or matters pending adjudication against the applicant.
5. The applicant's FMCSA MC#-135240-C is inactive and the applicant claims they are no longer taking vehicles out of Connecticut. The applicant voluntarily revoked their FMCSA MC# 135240-C on March 13, 2020.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to CGS Section 13b-103(a), this application is hereby approved and therefore Livery Permit Number 3454 is amended and reissued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3454 **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

BDL Livery, LLC dba Jaguar Limo is hereby permitted and authorized to operate NINE (9) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less in general livery service between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Windsor Locks.


This permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of this final decision. If at any time during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 2002-AVWO-22-L, the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of this permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
