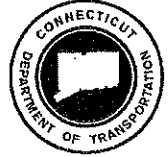

I. APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

By application 2003-TH-26-L filed on March 3, 2020, pursuant to Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.), American Livery Service, Inc. (hereinafter "applicant"), holder of Livery Permit Number 2196, seeks authorization from the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), to transfer its Norwalk headquarters to Fairfield, and close the Norwalk headquarters. Specifically, to transfer:

1. Sixteen (16) motor vehicles with a passenger capacity of ten (10) adults or less in general livery service. Granted pursuant to Docket # 1602-RE-19-L on February 23, 2016.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A legal notice was mailed to registered livery companies in the headquarters towns and towns contiguous to its headquarters town and was not opposed within the thirty (30) days as allowed by statute. The Department's staff has analyzed the evidence presented in this instant application and finds that it should be granted without a hearing.

III. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before this department.
2. The Department completed a headquarter check and finds that due to the COVID-19 situation, operation of some vehicles have been temporarily suspended, however, sixteen (16) vehicles shall be transferred to the new headquarters.
3. No opposition was filed by existing operators in the headquarters town.

IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-103, the instant application, given Application Number 2003-TH-26-L, filed by American Livery Service, Inc., is approved and Livery Permit Number 2196 is amended and reissued as follows:

**LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 2196**  
**FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

American Livery Service, Inc. is hereby permitted to operate sixteen (16) motor vehicles with a passenger seating capacity of ten (10) adults or less in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Fairfield, granted pursuant to Docket # 1602-RE-19-L on February 23, 2016.

In addition, American Livery Service, Inc. is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-188576-C.




**RESTRICTIONS:**

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
