REGISTRATION OF FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION
AUTHORITY

By application 2108-I-75-L, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on August 30, 2021, Lees Limousines LLC (hereinafter "applicant"), seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in certificate number MC-1242324-C, issued on May 15, 2021. The applicant submitted the requisite Criminal Conviction Information Report, conducted in accordance with Section 29-17a of the Connecticut General Statutes.

After consideration by the Department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-102(b), and Livery Permit Number 3720 is issued to Lees Limousines LLC in the following form:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3720
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Lees Limousines LLC is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-1242324-C.

In addition, Lees Limousines LLC is permitted and authorized to operate one (1) motor vehicle, having a seating capacity of less than fourteen (14) passengers, in general livery service from a headquarters in East Hartford.

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e. a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within ninety (90) days of the date of this decision.**
