INTRODUCTION

By application filed on August 19, 2021 with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Adnane Elarabi (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled his authority to Platinum Transportation, LLC. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 3708 is amended and re-issued as follows:

**LIVERY PERMIT NO. 3708
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

Platinum Transportation, LLC is authorized to operate five (5) motor vehicles in general livery service, with a seating capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers, from a headquarters in Hamden.

RESTRICTIONS:

The applicant must register and insure the five (5) general livery vehicles granted in this decision within ninety (90) days of the date of this decision.

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke said permit.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in each motor vehicles operated under this permit.
