INTRODUCTION

By application filed on September 7th, 2021 with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Kiss & Fly Limousine, LLC (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to Wanderley A Matos DBA Kiss & Fly Limousine. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 3375 is amended and re-issued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NO. 3375
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTERSTATE LIVERY SERVICE

Wanderley A Matos DBA Kiss & Fly Limousine is hereby permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of certificate number MC- 846808.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
