APPLICATION NO. 2110-RE-90-HG RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF 2BROSANDATRUCK, LLC TO ESTATE OF MATTHEW LEE WALKER

INTRODUCTION

By application filed on October 27, 2021, and assigned Application No. 2110-RE-9-HG, 2BROSANDATRUCK, LLC (hereinafter "applicant), holder of Certificate No. HG1787 seeks authorization from the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), to re-entitle its name to Estate of Matthew Lee Walker. Therefore, Certificate Number HG1787 is amended and re-issued as follows:

CERTIFICATE NO. HG1787 TO OPERATE MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PROPERTY FOR HIRE AS A MOTOR COMMON CARRIER

Estate of Matthew Lee Walker of East Haven, Connecticut, is hereby permitted and authorized, subject to such regulations and conditions as the Department may from time to time prescribe, to transport property for hire as a motor common carrier over irregular routes as follows:

Household goods, within the State of Connecticut, between all points upon calls received at its headquarters in East Haven.

The certificate holder must accept and transport property, as herein authorized, in accordance with its tariff on file, for all persons who desire the service to the extend of the certificate holder's facilities at uniform rate for all similar service.

CONDITIONS:

A motor vehicle must be registered under this certificate within sixty (60) days from the date of this decision.

The applicant must review the headquarters requirements with Department staff.

There shall be carried in each vehicle operated under this authority a copy of the certificate of registration receipt by the Department.

This certificate shall remain in effect until suspended, amended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the Certificate Holder to maintain proper insurance or to comply with all motor vehicle laws and

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other pertinent State statutes and/or the rules, regulation and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational for more than twenty-four (24) months.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder thereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules regulations and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe.
