## **INTRODUCTION**

By application 2112-I-117-B filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on December 29, 2021, The New Britain Transportation Company dba NBT Tours (hereinafter "applicant") of 257 Woodlawn Road, Berlin, Connecticut seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in Certificate No. MC-00000541-C issued on July 11, 2005.

After consideration by the Department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Sections 13b-88, 13b-89, and 13b-94a, and Interstate Charter Bus Permit No. 582 is issued to The New Britain Transportation Company dba NBT Tours in the following form:

## BUS PERMIT NO. 582 FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTERSTATE CHARTER BUS OPERATIONS

The New Britain Transportation Company dba NBT Tours is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter bus operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate No. MC-00000541-C.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State Statutes and/or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke the permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date on this decision.** 

Memorandum of the Permit, bearing the seal of the Department, shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
