INTRODUCTION

By application filed on March 23, 2022, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Elite Limousine Service, Inc dba Gardella's Elite Limousine Service (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to Elite Limousine Service, Inc dba Elite Limousine. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 2341 is amended and re-issued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NO. 2341
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Elite Limousine Service, Inc dba Elite Limousine is hereby permitted and authorized to operate eighteen (18) motor vehicles, each having a passenger seating capacity of ten (10) adults or less, in general livery service from a headquarters in Norwalk, Connecticut to all points in Connecticut.

Elite Limousine Service, Inc dba Elite Limousine is further permitted to operate motor vehicles with a seating capacity of ten (10) adults or less in interstate commerce under such authorization issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration by the issuance of Certificate Number MC 173698 as may be amended.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
