Subject: 2025-2026 Nirsevimab Supply and Ordering Update

This communication is being sent to all key contacts at provider organizations enrolled in the pediatric CT Vaccine Program (CVP) – please read this message in its entirety. Dear CVP providers,

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently notified the CT Department of Public Health (DPH) Immunization Program that we will continue to be on allocation of nirsevimab for the duration of the 2025–2026 respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) season. Similar to previous seasons, we will review and prioritize vaccine orders placed by birth hospitals and fill orders from other healthcare settings with remaining doses in the first few weeks. Furthermore, we will closely monitor orders, inventory and doses administered in the previous season to determine distribution among requesting clinics. This may mean that providers will not receive doses with initial allocations dates, however, we do not want to discourage providers from placing orders in case we have remaining doses.

Webinar

CDC will be hosting a webinar open to all enrolled CVP providers administering or planning to administer Nirsevimab on July 30, 2025, 2:30-4:00 P.M. This webinar will review

implementation of best practices to protect American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) infants and young children from severe RSV illness. This webinar is optional, but if you would like to attend you can register [here](#). You must register prior to the start of the meeting.

Nirsevimab Ordering

Please place nirsevimab orders using this [link](#) until November 24, 2025. Starting with the December 8th allocation, all orders will be placed directly in CT WiZ as we believe we will have adequate supply to fulfill all requests at this point in the season.

Below is the anticipated allocation schedule provided by CDC. We do anticipate receiving more doses compared to previous seasons. Please note that dates and allocation amounts are subject to change at any time. All orders placed via the link will be placed the day after the order submission date. If you place an order and you do not receive any doses for that allocation, please place a new order before the next date. DPH will not take previously submitted orders into account when allocating new doses received.

For example: if you place an order by the order deadline and do not receive the total amount requested that week, please place another order prior to the next submission deadline. We anticipate nirsevimab shipments to arrive within 5 business days once orders are placed.

Please ensure you are rotating stock and using last year's supply before any newer doses that you may receive. RSV is part of the CVP program and any doses that are wasted are subject to the [restitution policy](#) and will need to be replaced. Clinics should not be ordering for the entire RSV season with the first allocation rather order as needed throughout the season. If you need assistance in redistributing your doses, please contact the Immunization Program directly via the [help desk](#) (select: Immunizations CT WiZ –Clinic Administration-CT WiZ Training and Inventory Support-CT WiZ Inventory Management) for assistance.

All other CVP vaccines should continue to be placed directly in CT WiZ.

Clesrovimab Coming Soon!

Clesrovimab is a new one-dose monoclonal antibody approved by FDA for infants whose mothers are not protected by maternal RSV vaccination. Clesrovimab is not available to order at this time and providers should not delay ordering to wait for this new product as we don't have a timeline for its availability yet. More information regarding administration and availability through the CVP program will be communicated when available.
