- 1. The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$183,949.00 from \$183,949.00 to \$367,898.00. The additional funds are due to receipt of the FFY 2017 federal grant award for the SNAP employment and training program.
- The budget on page 11 of the original contract is hereby deleted and shall be replaced with the budget on page 2 of this amendment

All terms and conditions of the original Contract, and any subsequent amendments thereto, which were not modified by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.
