The contract between Yale University (the Contractor) and the Department of Social Services (the Department), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Office of the Attorney General on 3/3/15, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. The total maximum amount payable under this contract is increased by \$282,699 from \$584,748 to \$867,447 to add funding for the fifth (5th) year of the federal award for the Rewards to Quit (RTQ) program.

2. The combined budget for years 1 through 5 shall be as follows:
