<p><b>State of CT Dept. of Housing</b></p>	<p>CTHousingSearch is a housing locator service helps Connecticut residents to find available housing that meets the needs of their family. The service can be accessed online 24 hours a day and is supported by a toll-free, bilingual call center M-F: 9am-8pm. No in-person service available. People can search for housing using a wide variety of search criteria with special mapping features and receive apartment listings that provide important information about each unit. <p><b>State of CT Dept. of Housing</b></p>	<p>2-1-1 maintains the Housing Choice Voucher (a.k.a. Section 8) waiting list notification web site. Public Act 04-258 requires that housing authorities and property owners that accept choice vouchers in Connecticut post a notice on this web site (cthcvp.org) at least two weeks before they open a Section 8 waiting list. People with internet access can use this web site to locate open Housing Choice Voucher waiting lists and post notifications when their open waiting lists become available.
