Dear Mr. Sullivan:

On May 10, 2006, the Office of Health Care Access (“OHCA”) received your request for the relocation of Midwestern Connecticut Council on Alcoholism, Inc.’s (“MCCA”) New Milford location. OHCA has reviewed your request and makes the following findings:

1. Midwestern Connecticut Council on Alcoholism, Inc.’s (“MCCA”) is a non-profit facility providing adult and adolescent outpatient substance abuse treatment at various locations in Connecticut.
2. MCCA is proposing to relocate its day/evening and outpatient programs for substance abusive or dependent persons from 23 Poplar Street, New Milford to 17 East Street, New Milford.
3. The proposed new location is located approximately one half mile from the current location.
4. The primary service area and target population will not change as a result of the relocation of the program.
5. No additional programs are proposed and no programs will be terminated.
6. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$5,000.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for you to proceed with the relocation of your program. Termination of these services would require Certificate of Need approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
