Relocation of Mammography Services in Waterbury

Dear Ms. Scott:

On October 4, 2006, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your request for the relocation of the Mammography Services from Brass Mill Center Mall, Waterbury, Connecticut, to 64 Robbins Street, Waterbury, Connecticut.

Please be advised that OHCA has reviewed your request and makes the following findings:

1. Waterbury Hospital, whose main campus is located at 64 Robbins Street, Waterbury, Connecticut, is an acute care general hospital.
2. Waterbury Hospital is proposing to relocate its Mammography Services from Brass Mill Center Mall, Waterbury, Connecticut, to 64 Robbins Street, Waterbury, Connecticut. This will allow the Hospital to realize enhanced operating efficiencies.
3. The primary service area and target population will not change as a result of the relocation of the program.
4. No additional programs are proposed and no programs will be terminated.
5. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$500.00.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for you to proceed with the relocation of your services. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
