Closing three clinics on Sundays

Dear Mr. Bilangi:

On November 2, 2006, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your request for the closing of three clinics on Sundays in Danbury, Waterbury and Norwalk, Connecticut.

Please be advised that OHCA has reviewed your request and makes the following findings:

1. Connecticut Counseling Centers, Inc. ("CCCI") is a non-profit facility providing adult outpatient psychiatric and substance abuse treatment at various locations in Connecticut.
2. CCCI is proposing to close three clinics on Sundays in Danbury, Waterbury and Norwalk, Connecticut.
3. The primary service area and target population will not change as a result of the closing of the clinics on Sundays.
4. No additional programs are proposed and no programs will be terminated.
5. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$0.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for you to proceed with the closing of the clinics on Sundays at Danbury, Waterbury and Norwalk. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
