Dear Ms. Hawley:

On July 31, 2008, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request concerning the proposal of Catholic Charities, Inc. - Archdiocese of Hartford for the relocation of its outpatient psychiatric clinic for children from 67 Holmes Avenue in Waterbury to 13 Wolcott Street in Waterbury, Connecticut. OHCA has reviewed the information contained in your CON Determination request letter and makes the following findings:

1. Catholic Charities, Inc. - Archdiocese of Hartford ("CCI") is a non-profit facility providing outpatient psychiatric clinic services for children at 67 Holmes Avenue in Waterbury, Connecticut.
2. CCI is proposing to relocate its outpatient psychiatric clinic for children from 67 Holmes Avenue in Waterbury to 13 Wolcott Street in Waterbury, Connecticut. This new facility will allow CCI to better serve its clients through allocation of larger space, family friendly environment, and better security.
3. CCI located at 67 Holmes Avenue in the town of Waterbury is currently licensed as an Outpatient Psychiatric Clinic for Children by the State of Connecticut, Department of Children and Families.
4. CCI indicates that they provide outpatient therapy, consisting of individual, family and group therapy for children ages 5-18 years old.

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5. CCI will be responsible for the billing of the services related to the proposal.
6. The service area and target population will not change as a result of the relocation of the existing licensed services for children.
7. No additional programs are proposed and no services will be terminated.
8. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$500,000.

Based on these findings, OHCA has determined that Certificate of Need approval is not required for Catholic Charities, Inc. – Archdiocese of Hartford to proceed with the relocation of its outpatient psychiatric clinic for children from 67 Holmes Avenue in Waterbury to 13 Wolcott Street in Waterbury, Connecticut. Termination of these services would require CON approval, pursuant to Section 19a-638, C.G.S.
