On June 4, 2010, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request concerning the proposal of Yale-New Haven Hospital ("YNHH"), to relocate its Temple Radiology Office ("TRO") from 190 Main Street, East Haven, to 272 Main Street, East Haven, Connecticut. OHCA has reviewed the information contained in your CON Determination request letter and makes the following findings:


1. YNHH is a short term acute care general hospital located at 20 York Street in New Haven, Connecticut.
2. YNHH currently provides general radiography and radiology services at TRO, located at 190 Main Street in East Haven, Connecticut.
3. YNHH is proposing to relocate TRO to 272 Main Street in East Haven, Connecticut.
4. The service area and target population will not change as a result of the relocation.
5. No additional programs are proposed and no services will be terminated.
6. The total capital expenditure associated with this relocation is \$1,347,577.

Based upon the foregoing, OHCA has determined that Yale-New Haven Hospital's proposal to relocate Temple Radiology Office within East Haven does not require CON approval. The proposed relocation does not involve the establishment of an additional

function or service or the termination of services under General Statutes § 19a-638. Additionally, the capital expenditure associated with the proposal does not exceed the threshold under General Statutes § 19a-639.
