Dear Dr. Badiola:

On October 25, 2010, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") Determination request concerning the proposal of Radiologic Associates, P.C. ("Practice") to replace its existing Magnetic Resonance Imaging ("MRI") and Computed Tomography ("CT") scanners and relocate them within the town of Farmington.

Pursuant to Public Act 10-179 § 87 (b) (18), the Practice's proposal to replace its existing MRI scanner & CT scanner, acquired under Report Numbers: 03-30098-DTR and 05-30495, does not require CON approval. The Practice is required to notify OHCA of the date the existing MRI scanner and CT scanner are replaced as well as the disposition of the replaced scanners.

Additionally, the Practice is proposing to relocate its MRI scanner and CT scanner from its current office located at 353 Scott Swamp Road, Farmington to The Exchange, 270 Farmington Avenue, Farmington. The relocation of imaging equipment does not require CON approval.
