On December 6, 2010, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received the request of Southern Connecticut Imaging Centers, LLC d/b/a Whitney Imaging Center's ("Applicant") seeking waiver to replace its existing 4-Slice Computed Tomography ("CT") Scanner with a 16-Slice CT Scanner. Pursuant to General Statutes §19a-638 (b) (18), as amended by Public Act 10-179, the Applicant's proposal does not require CON approval. The Applicant is required to notify OHCA of the date on which the existing CT Scanner is replaced as well as the disposition of the replaced CT Scanner.
