Dear Dr. Blau:

On December 21, 2012, the Office of Health Care Access ("OHCA") received your Certificate of Need ("CON") determination request on behalf of Mandell & Blau, M.D.s, P.C. d/b/a Open MRI at Buckland Hills ("Petitioner") with respect to whether a CON is required for the Petitioner to replace and relocate its previously approved Computed Tomography ("CT") scanner.

Under Docket Number 05-30569-CON, OHCA authorized the Petitioner to acquire an 8-Slice CT scanner. The Petitioner is now proposing to replace it with a newer 32-Slice CT scanner and move it from 491 Buckland Road, South Windsor to 1165 Tolland Turnpike, Manchester.

Thank you for informing OHCA of your plans, however, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 19a-638, a CON is not required for the Petitioner to replace and relocate its current CT scanner. Please be advised that when the Petitioner does replace its previously authorized CT scanner, it is required to complete the enclosed CON Notification Form and file it with OHCA.
