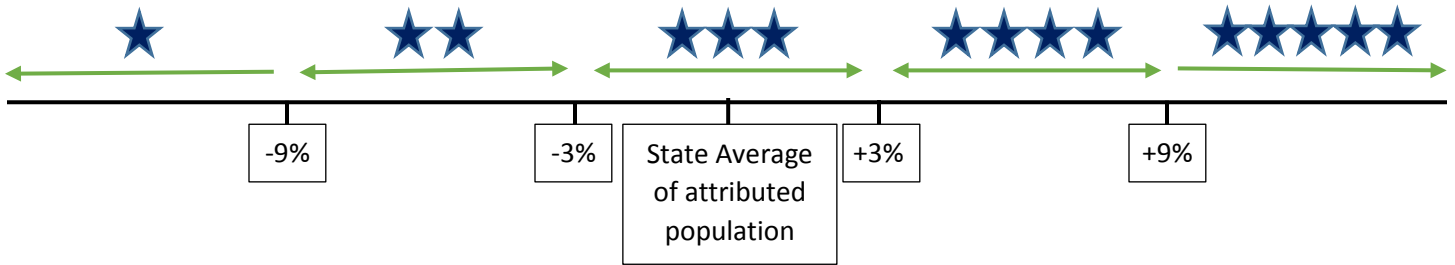


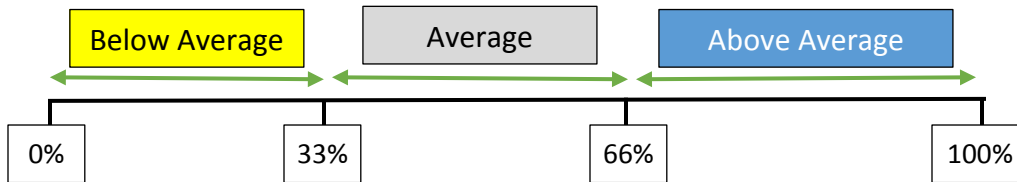
HealthQualityCT Rating Options

HealthQualityCT will provide a rating for performance on each quality measure for every Advanced Network (AN). Three options exist for rating strategies:

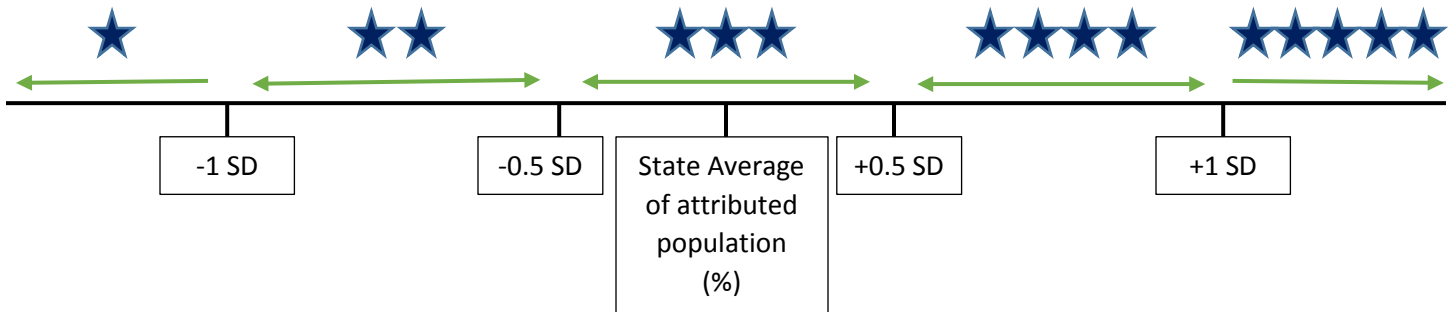
Option 1: Substantive deviation. In this rating strategy, ANs are placed in rating categories based on an arbitrary deviation from the state average of attributed population.



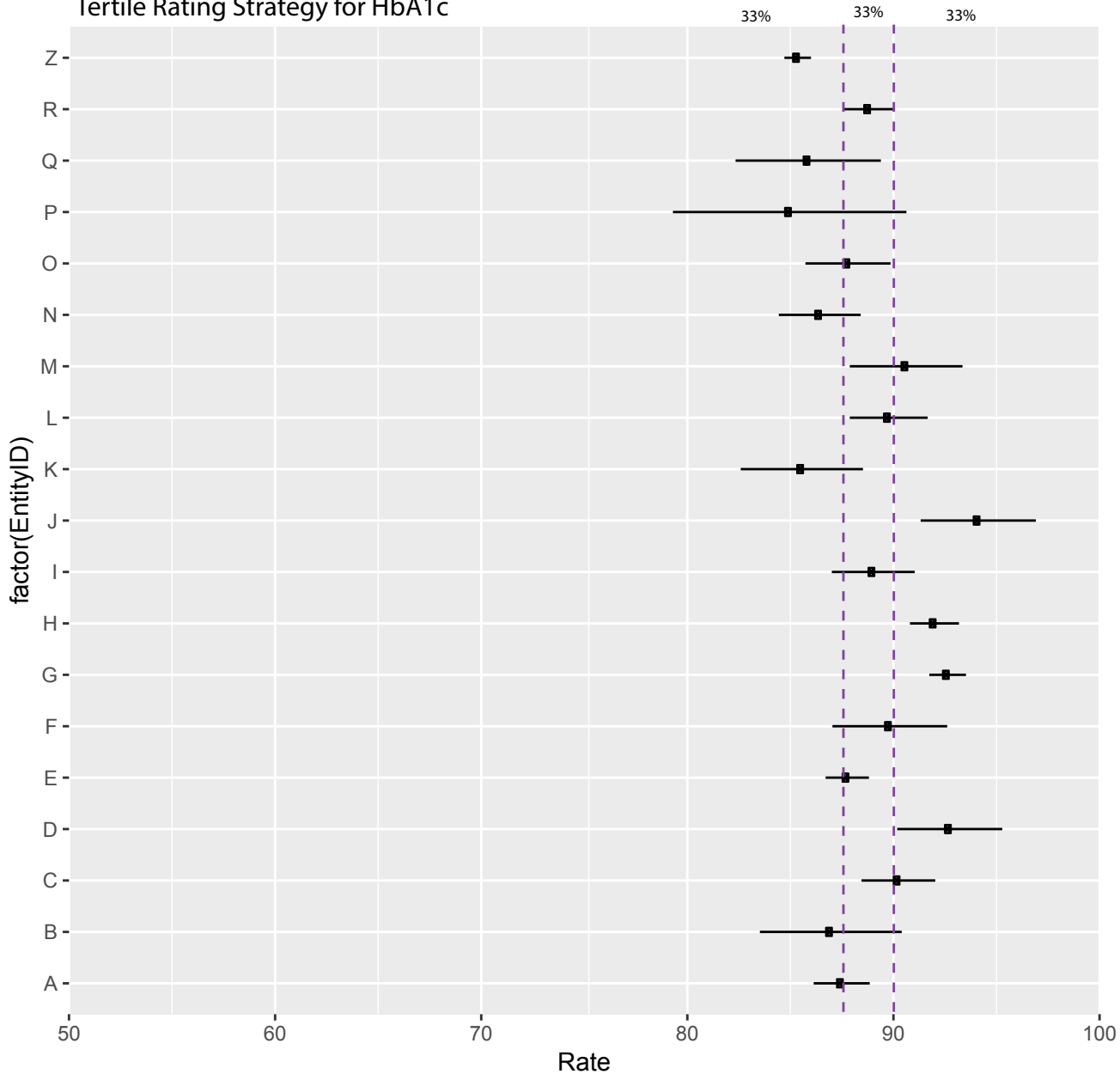
Option 2: Tertiles. In this rating strategy performance, ANs are placed in categories based on performance relative to other ANs. In this strategy, 1/3 of ANs will fall in each of the three categories regardless of how much they deviate from the state average or each other.



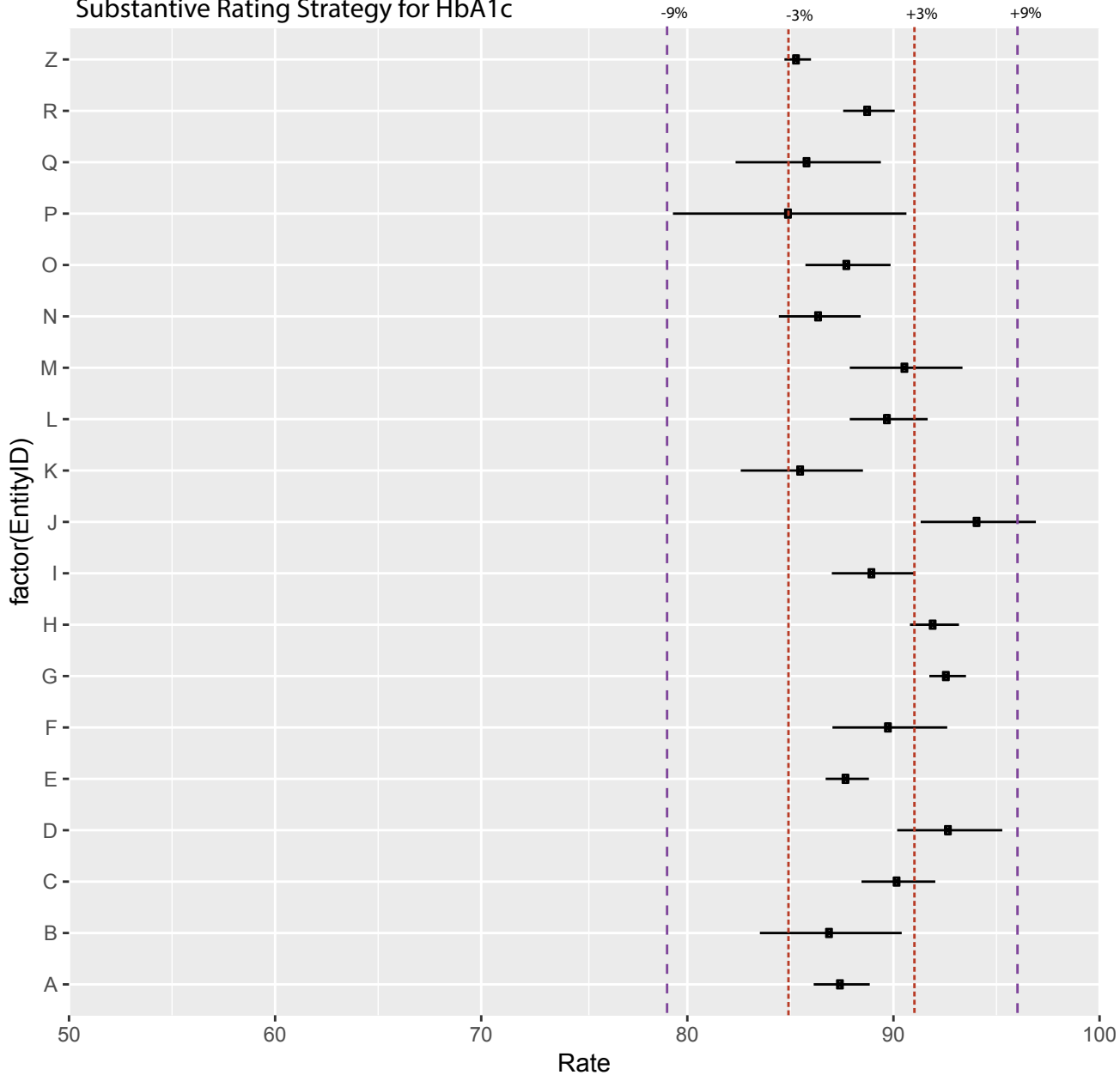
Option 3: Statistical deviation. In this strategy, the standard deviation is calculated based on the distribution of the rates for each AN. ANs are placed in a rating category based on how statistically different they are from the state average obtained from the attributed population.



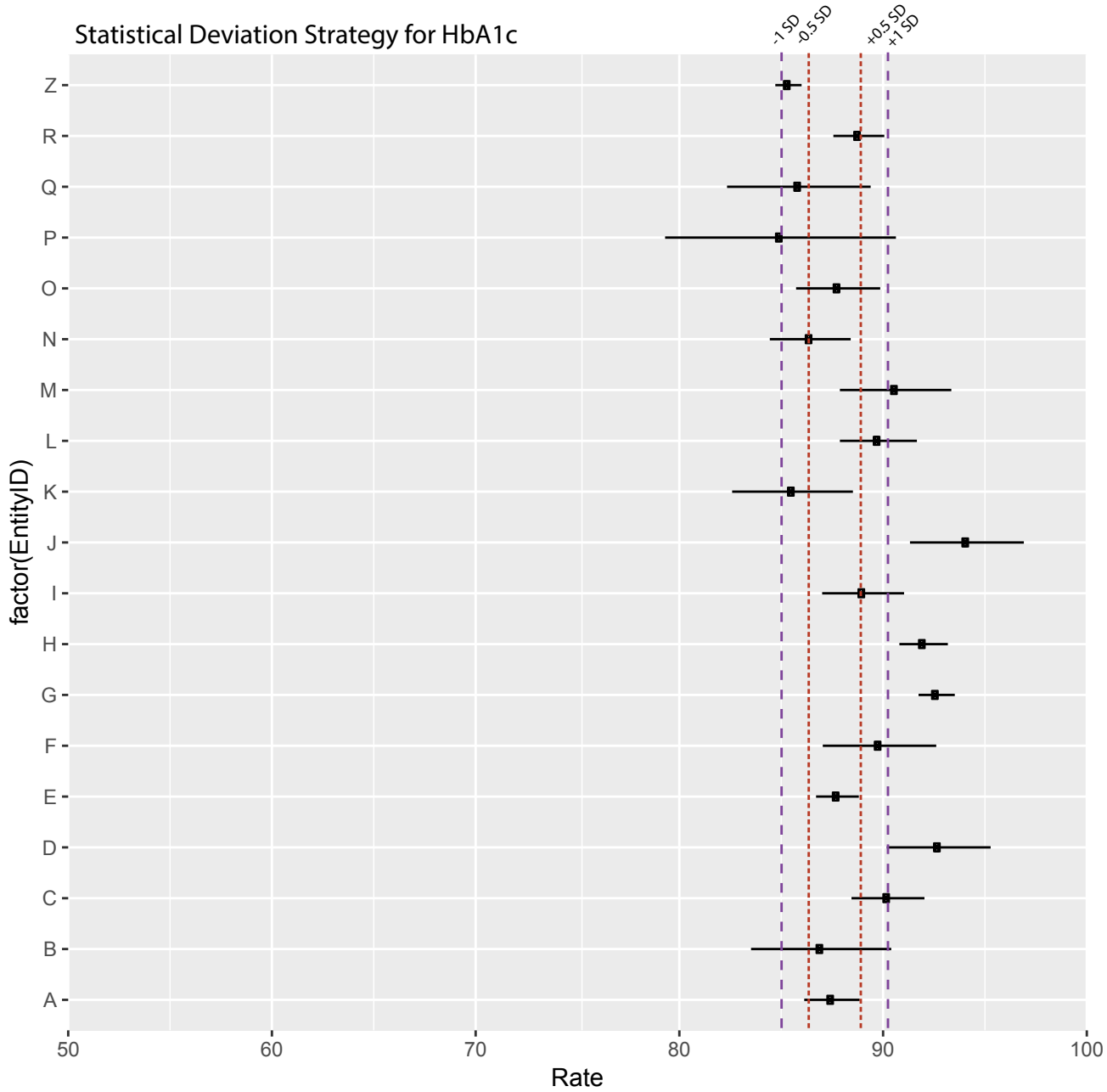
Tertile Rating Strategy for HbA1c



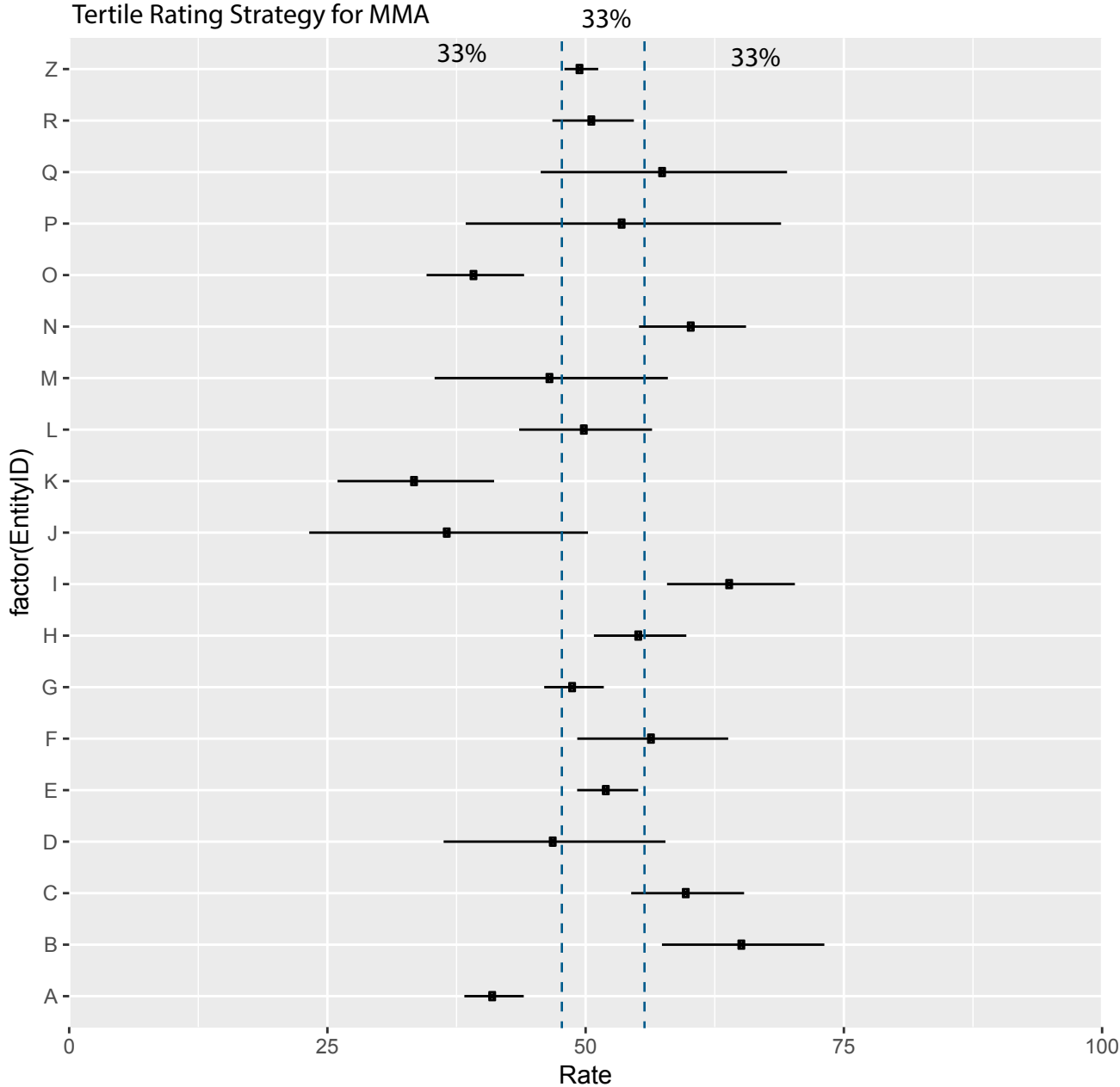
Substantive Rating Strategy for HbA1c



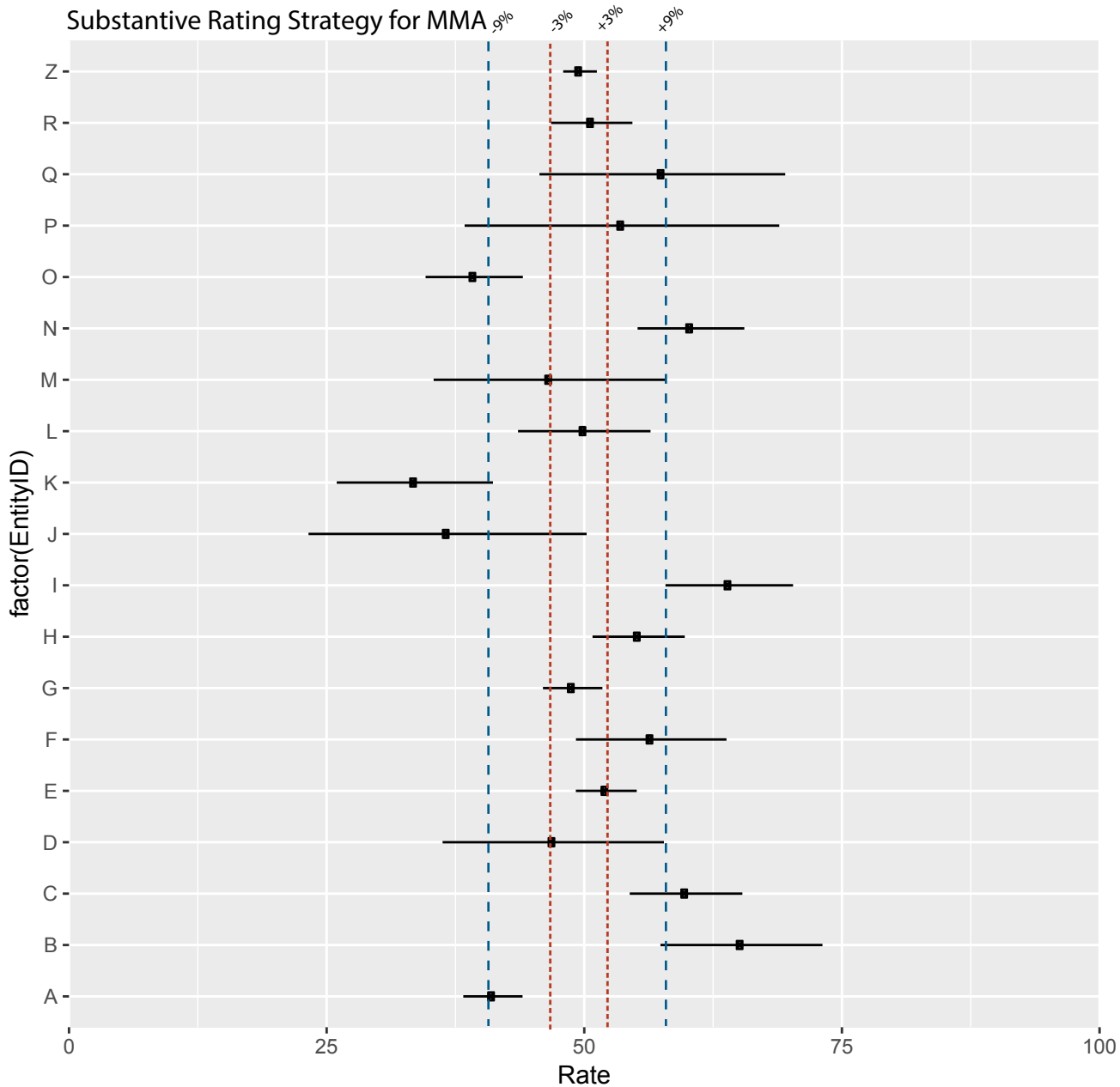
Statistical Deviation Strategy for HbA1c
